

## THE GUSTAV ROSENBERGER AWARD 2020 IS OPEN FOR SUBMISSIONS

The Gustav Rosenberger Memorial Fund (GRMF) is a tribute to Dr Gustav Rosenberger and is related to the World Association for Buiatrics. The Gustav Rosenberger Memorial Fund has the objective to 'further improve bovine medicine at an international level and to stimulate bovine research in its broadest sense'. To realize that objective, bovine scientists have been awarded, mainly being young scientists from South America, Eastern Europe, Asia and Africa. On a yearly base a € 10.000,- grant is offered, to be used for educational and research purposes.

#### The GRMF award

The GRMF award is delivered to young and promising cattle veterinarians who:

- Come from a country where bovine medicine needs further development;
- Have an attractive plan they are working on in that field;
- Intend to apply the knowledge obtained in that country.

The grant is to be used for an educative period of at least 3 months, which is intended to increase the candidates knowledge on bovine veterinary medicine by following courses or doing research.

Candidates for the GRMF award are veterinarians working in bovine medicine that have been graduated no longer than 10 years at the moment they receive the grant. Candidates are invited to send an application form as is presented on the website of the GRMF ([www.gustavrosenberger.com](http://www.gustavrosenberger.com)) before 1 September 2020.

In 2020 the GRMF award will be presented during the annual general meeting of the European College of Bovine Health Management. Due to the SARS-COV II pandemic, this will be an online event that will take place on Tuesday 29 September.
