Winner of the 12th Gustav Rosenberg Award

The Board of the Gustav Rosenberger Memorial Fund has decided that on June 3rd 2012, at the 27th World Buiatrics Congress in Lisbon Portugal, the Gustav Rosenberger Award 2012 will be presented to

Dr. Shailesh S. Madane

Dr Madane was selected from 7 excellent candidates. He is a young, promising veterinarian, who impressed the jury with his research plans in which he focuses on prudent antibiotic use in dry cows, that fit well within the scope of our fund. Dr. Madane received his education from Bombay Veterinary College of Maharashtra Animal and Fishery Sciences University, India. The € 10.000 grant that accompanies the award will help him to realize his research plans at Cornell University in New York, where he will work at the Quality Milk Production Services (QMPS) laboratory. The research of Dr Madane will focus on selective use of antibiotics in dry cow therapy in herds with low prevalence of *Streptococcus agalactiae* and *Staphylococcus aureus*.

In 2013 the Gustav Rosenberger Award will again be presented for postgraduate studies in bovine medicine. All veterinarians with an interest in bovine medicine are invited to apply. Candidates preferably come from a country or area with suboptimal possibilities for further development of bovine medicine. The grant has to be used for an educative period of at least three months, which is intended to improve the candidates' knowledge on bovine veterinary medicine by following courses or doing research.
