Winner of the 16th Gustav Rosenberg Award

The Board of the Gustav Rosenberger Memorial Fund has decided that on July 3rd 2016, at the 29th World Buiatrics Congress in Dublin Ireland, the Gustav Rosenberger Award 2016 will be presented to

Dr. Guilherme Rizzoto

Guilherme Rizzoto received his education from the Federal University of Pelotas, Brazil. As part of his veterinary training, he did a mandatory internship (1 year) at the University of Calgary. The € 10.000 grant that accompanies the award will allow him to conduct comparative studies of scrotal/testicular thermoregulation with *Bos indicus*, *Bos taurus*, and crossbred bulls in Brazil as part of a MS program at the University of Calgary. His thesis research will involve a very broad range of techniques. In addition, he will take graduate courses in reproductive physiology, experimental design and statistical methods.

In 2017 the Gustav Rosenberger Award will again be presented for postgraduate studies in bovine medicine. All veterinarians with an interest in bovine medicine are invited to apply. Candidates preferably come from a country or area with suboptimal possibilities for further development of bovine medicine. The grant has to be used for an educative period of at least three months, which is intended to improve the candidates' knowledge on bovine veterinary medicine by following courses or doing research.
