## **Gustav Rosenberger Award 2022 for Susan Pyakurel DVM**

The 2022 Gustav Rosenberger Award will be presented to **Mr. Susan Pyakurel DVM** from Nepal. The Award, a grant of €10.000, will be used for a study on microbiological aspects of bovine foot rot (BFR) and digital dermatitis (BDD), the leading causes of bovine lameness, by applying high-throughput sequencing and quantification tools to understand the role of the microbiome in close collaboration with the University of Calgary, Canada.

The award was presented during the Opening Ceremony of the World Buiatrics Congress in Madrid, Spain, and was hosted by Prof. Dr. Theo Lam, chairman of the Gustav Rosenberger Memorial Fund.

The Gustav Rosenberger Memorial Fund annually provides a grant to a young and promising veterinarian, preferably from a country or area with suboptimal possibilities to develop veterinary knowledge in the field of cattle health and was generously sponsored by [Boehringer Ingelheim](#).
