Gustav Rosenberger Award 2024 for Istianah Maryam Jamilah

The 2024 Gustav Rosenberger Award will be presented to **Istianah Maryam Jamilah (Mila)** from Indonesia. The Award, a grant of €10.000, will be used for a study on the attitude of Indonesian dairy farmers towards animal welfare and how those attitudes are reflected in welfare outcomes and productivity. This will be carried out in close collaboration with prof. dr. Richard Laven from Massey University, New Zealand.

The award will be presented on 20 May, during the Grand Opening Ceremony of the World Buiatrics Congress that will be held in Cancún, Mexico. Mila will be awarded by dr. Ruurd Jorritsma, board member of the Gustav Rosenberger Memorial Fund.

The Gustav Rosenberger Memorial Fund annually provides a grant to a young and promising veterinarian, preferably from a country or area with suboptimal possibilities to develop veterinary knowledge in the field of cattle health and is sponsored by [Boehringer Ingelheim](#).
